Payment structure includes the rates of Minimum Wages and all other Statutory Payments at prevailing rates (Central Government /State Government) <b><u>whichever is higher.</u></b></p> <p>It is mandatory for Vendor to attach latest Government(Central/State) orders in this regard.</p>
	<p>--</p>	<p>It is further clarified, that on receipt of Government orders from time to time relating to hike in statutory payments like DA, vendor has to submit the proposal alongwith the necessary orders for the same. The same will be reimbursed by FTII.</p>
