Radio FTII to broadcast series on malnutrition

A series on the issues of malnutrition among children will be aired by Radio FTII (90.4 MHz), the community radio of the Film and Television Institute of India, from mid-February. The series is part of a nationwide campaign launched by the NGO, Save the Children, and aims at raising awareness on malnutrition and effective ways to counter it. The 30-minute episodes in Marathi will be based on topics like malnutrition in Pune, neo-natal care, mortality rate, and the implementation and effectiveness of the National Rural Health Mission launched by the ministry of health and family welfare.
